

Sept. 18, 2013

I attended the Palliser Park Aug. Board Meeting Sept. 18, 2013.

At this meeting the following were discussed:

- There was a discussion held regarding the ability to put sewer into Lakeview. The proposal was brought forth by Dave Montgomery and is not feasible.
- The No Fishing signs on the dock were put back up when these were taken down. Fishing is not allowed off the docks.
- There was a second proposal for the Pipeline project presented. The Pipeline water project will be going ahead.
- Rocks are needed as the shore line is washing away.
- It was suggested that the pool may be leaking. It is felt that the water level is lower than just evaporation would allow for. This will be monitored.
- There was a request for a permanent mobile cottage to be built in a PTC. This was denied.
- There was a request for a trailer to be left over winter in a non-seasonal site. This was denied.
- Speed bumps were discussed. The staff felt much safer in the Gate Entrance building. These will be put up again next year.
- Roads will be graded and gravelled this year.
- Electrical – the Sask Power electrical inspector found the fuel tank at the Marina unacceptable. This will be corrected immediately. We have the submersible pump already, and the electrician will come and correct the wiring. There is no need for more fuel storage at the Marina. We need to organize fuel delivery. There is no need for a new tank. We will have some repairs and additions to the current system.
- A review of staff was done. Only Ken, Al, and Bob are still working. We will call in summer students for some weekend work if need be.
- The Lagoon has been finished.
- DLCD and PRPA are in disagreement with the 10.5% mill rate and are scheduled to go to Court shortly. Discussions were held to see what could be done to have a mediation session. It was felt the only ones winning in this situation are the lawyers. Hopefully the parties can work this out.
- There has been a stainless steel table installed in the fish shack.
- The fire guard on Harold Langer's property was discussed. It has been worked.
- Discussion was held on the length of the Lease for the PTC's.
